Oren Becher, MD, is chief of the Jack Martin Fund Division of Pediatric Hematology-Oncology at the Mount Sinai Kravis Children's Hospital. Dr. Becher earned his BA magna cum laude from the University of Pennsylvania, and MD from Johns Hopkins School of Medicine. He completed his pediatric residency at Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC, and fellowships in Pediatric Hematology-Oncology and Pediatric Neuro-Oncology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in NYC. Dr. Becher served on the faculty at Duke University and Northwestern University prior to relocating to Mount Sinai. Dr. Becher's research, funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIH), and Department of Defense (DOD) uses genetic mouse models to identify more effective therapies for children with DIPG or diffuse intrinsic pontine glioma, an incurable brain cancer in children.
