She is the Vice Chair for the Type 1 Diabetes TrialNet research network and the co-PI of the DiabDocs K12 National Physician Scientist Development Program. She also is engaged in research in metabolic bone disorders. She is a graduate of the Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine Fellowship program.

Locally she serves as the Indiana Clinical and Translational Research Institute (CTSI) Director of Career Development and co-chairs the CTSI Pediatric Project Development Team.
