Robert W. Frenck, Jr, MD, received his undergraduate degree from the Univ. of Calif at San Diego in 1977 followed by his doctor of medicine degree from the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston in 1981. He completed his residency in pediatrics at the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, Maryland followed by a pediatric infectious disease fellowship at the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston. After a 27-year career, Dr Frenck retired from the Navy and joined Cincinnati Children's Hospital in 2006. Dr. Frenck is board-certified in both pediatrics and infectious diseases. Dr Frenck maintains an active research portfolio including therapeutic and vaccine clinical trials with special interest in enteric diseases. He has published over 150 articles in the peer-reviewed literature including 11 articles on COVID-19 vaccine clinical trials. Dr Frenck is a Professor of Pediatrics in the Division of Infectious Diseases at Cincinnati Children's Hospital and is the Director for their Center for Vaccine Research.
