Julie Goodwin, MD, completed her undergraduate degree at Dartmouth College and her medical training at Boston University School of Medicine. She completed her pediatrics internship and residency at Georgetown University Hospital in Washington DC and then moved to Yale University School of Medicine where she completed her fellowship training in pediatric nephrology. She then joined the faculty at Yale where she has remained for the entirety of her career so far. Dr. Goodwin is an NIH-funded investigator with a laboratory in the Vascular Biology and Therapeutics program at Yale. Her research interests include cell-specific steroid microenvironments, with a particular focus on endothelial cells and vascular inflammation, renal fibrosis and Wnt signaling, and the mechanistic underpinnings of cardiorenal disease. Dr. Goodwin is active in the American Society of Pediatric Nephrology (ASPN), serves as secretary of the Eastern Society for Pediatric Research (ESPR) and is the current Chair of the Scientific Review Committee for the Charles H. Hood Foundation Child Health Research Awards.
