Rubia Khalak, MD is Professor of Pediatrics at Albany Medical Center. She completed her pediatric residency and neonatal fellowship at the University of Rochester. Dr. Khalak divides her time between working as a neonatologist at AMC and associate dean work at the medical school. Her research interests include clinical exam findings in necrotizing enterocolitis and scoring rubrics to assess need for surgery. She has also published on the impact of maternal obesity on the neonate, and recently served as co-editor on the topic for Frontiers in Neonatology. Dr. Khalak serves as President-Elect for the Eastern Society for Pediatric Research and will start her tenure as President of ESPR in 2023. She is also a mentor to faculty and fellows both at her home institution and nationally through the AAP Mentorship Program. Dr. Khalak is Associate Dean of Enrollment Management and Administration for Albany Medical College, leading the medical school admissions team through each cycle of recruitment and enrollment. She serves as an Advising Dean to assigned AMC medical students throughout their four years and writes Deans Letters for their ERAS application. She also serves as the AAMC-GSA group liaison to the national AAMC-SSAC Committee.
