Teresia O'Connor is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at Baylor College of Medicine in the USDA/ARS Children's Nutrition Research Center and division of Academic General Pediatrics. She is a board-certified, practicing general pediatrician and fellowship trained clinician researcher. Dr. O'Connor's NIH and USDA funded research program focuses on a) identifying strategies to best prevent and treat childhood obesity; b) providing better understanding of how parents (fathers and mothers) influence their children's obesity-related behaviors through the framework of parenting styles, feeding styles, and parenting practices; and c) assessing how to use technology to improve the measurement of children's obesity-related behaviors. Dr. O'Connor serves on the councils for the Society of Pediatric Research and the International Society of Behavioral Nutrition and Physical Activity.
