Dr. Yasmín Pedrogo is a Professor and the Vice-Chair for Academic Affairs of the Department of Pediatrics and the Clinical Director of the Clinical Skills Center of the University of Puerto Rico School of Medicine (UPR-SOM). She completed a bachelor's degree from the University of Puerto Rico, a Doctor of Medicine degree from the UPR-SOM, a master's degree in Medical Education and Leadership from the University of New England in Maine and a scholarship in Health System Science of the American Medical Association. In addition, she obtained a specialty in Pediatrics and a subspecialty in Pediatrics Hospital Medicine, being certified by the American Board of Pediatrics in both areas.

As a medical educator with more than 15 years of experience, Dr. Pedrogo has served in multiple academic committees and leadership roles within the Medical Sciences Campus including Director of the Residency Program of the General Pediatrics Residency Program, Interim Associate Dean for Academic Affairs of the MSC- UPR, Director of the Curriculum Office, Director of the Faculty Development Program, Leader of the Strategic Plan Committee of the School of Medicine, director of multiple courses and member of the WHO-2 Task Force of the AAMC. Her academic areas of interest include curricular development, CBME teaching and assessment, Clinical Skills, Health System Sciences, Faculty and Professional Development. She developed the first longitudinal curriculum of Interprofessional Education, Patient Safety and Quality Improvement of the School of Medicine, among others.
