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Dr. John Carter Ralphe is the chief of the Division of Pediatric Cardiology within the UW School of Medicine and Public Health and co-director of UW Health's Congenital Heart Program. He is board certified in pediatric cardiology. Dr. Ralphe's clinical interests include diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, and acquired and familial forms of cardiomyopathy. He holds the Ellen and Arnold Wald Chair in Pediatric Research and directs a cardiovascular physiology lab that studies genetic forms of hypertrophic cardiomyopathy using human iPS-cell based functional engineered cardiac tissue models.
