Taylor Sawyer, DO, MBA, Med, is a Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Washington School of Medicine and Medical Director of the Seattle Children's Hospital Simulation Program. Dr. Sawyer is an internationally recognized expert in simulation-based education. His work focuses on improving procedural competency and resuscitation performance. He has published over 100 peer-reviewed manuscripts and over a dozen book chapters. He has received over \$3.5M in extramural grant funding from a range of organizations including the Department of Defense and the National Institute for Health. He has received advanced certification as a healthcare simulation educator (CHSE-A) from the Society for Simulation in Healthcare. Dr. Sawyer's leadership positions include Founder and former Chair of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Section on Simulation and Innovative Learning Methods; former Executive Committee Member of the AAP Section on Osteopathic Pediatricians; former Member of the American Heart Association (AHA) Get With the Guidelines Pediatric Research Taskforce; former Member of the AAP Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) Steering Committee. He currently serves as a Member of the AHA Education Writing Group; Member of the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation (ILCOR) Education, Implementation, and Teams Task Force; and President of the International Pediatric Simulation Society.
