Jessica Snowden, MD, MS, MHPTT, is Professor of Pediatrics, Vice Dean for Research, and Chief of the Division of Pediatric Infectious Disease at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences in Little Rock, Arkansas. She is the Principal Investigator of the IDeA States Pediatric Clinical Trial Network's Data Coordinating and Operations Center, directing clinical operations for trial implementation and professional development across an 18-state NIH funded research group. She holds the Horace C. Cabe Endowed Chair in Pediatric Infectious Disease. In addition to her clinical research, she has a long history of active involvement in NIH-funded basic science research; medical student, resident, <u>and</u> fellow education; and multiple awards for her excellence in teaching, research, and hospital quality. She has been recognized as a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics (FAAP), Fellow of the Pediatric Infectious Disease Society (FPIDS), and Fellow of the Infectious Disease Society of America (FIDSA) and is a member of several national committees focused on medical research.
