Jörn-Hendrik Weitkamp, MD, is Professor of Pediatrics and attending physician in the Mildred Stahlman Division of Neonatology at Vanderbilt University Medical Center and Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt in Nashville, Tennessee. Dr. Weitkamp received his medical degree *summa cum laude* from the University of Ulm in Germany and completed his residency in Pediatrics at the University Hospital of Bonn in Germany and at Vanderbilt University Medical Center. He subsequently completed fellowships in Pediatric Infectious Diseases and Perinatal-Neonatal Medicine at Vanderbilt.

The focus of Dr. Weitkamp's research and scholarly work has been in neonatal immunology, neonatal infectious disease and necrotizing enterocolitis. He is specifically interested in the prenatal influences on the developing immune system. As Director for Patient-Oriented Research, Dr. Weitkamp oversees numerous clinical trials and translational studies in neonatology and is a voting member on the Institutional Review Board (IRB). Dr. Weitkamp has served on international and NIH study sections and chairs the Research Committee of the American Academy of Pediatrics Section on Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine.
