2023 JOHN HOWLAND AWARD RECIPIENT



Yvonne (Bonnie) Maldonado, MD, is the Senior Associate Dean for Faculty Development; Taube Endowed Professor of Global Health and Infectious Diseases; Professor of Pediatrics and of Epidemiology and Population Health; and Chief, Division of Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Stanford University School of Medicine. She is also the Co-Medical Director, Infection Prevention and Control; and Attending Physician at Lucile Packard Children's Hospital Stanford.

Dr. Maldonado is recognized internationally for her accomplishments as a clinician-investigator and academic leader in pediatric infectious disease epidemiology. After her medical training, she served as an Epidemiologic Intelligence Surveillance Officer for the

Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). Dr. Maldonado has led several NIH, CDC, Gates Foundation, and WHO-funded domestic and international pediatric vaccine studies, as well as studies in the prevention and treatment of perinatal HIV infection in the US, India, Mexico, and Africa. Dr. Maldonado's other significant contributions include her work in polio eradication, some of which include her studies with colleagues in Mexico that helped inform the development of novel oral polio vaccines and her efforts to enhance environmental assays for assessment of oral poliovirus circulation, to name just a few.

Beyond her roles as a clinician-investigator and academic, Dr. Maldonado has been an extraordinary mentor in academic pediatrics, having nurtured the careers of women and underrepresented minorities in medicine. She has been a pioneer in championing diversity efforts in medical schools and universities throughout her career. This work involves undertaking research on equity, diversity, and health disparities and designing education programs for students of all cultural backgrounds.
