Jon Bernstein is a geneticist at Stanford University and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital at Stanford specializing in the diagnosis, discovery and delineation of rare genetic conditions with an emphasis on neurodevelopmental disorders. He is additionally the Chief of the Division of Medical Genetics and the Medical Director of the Stanford Cleft and Craniofacial center. His research efforts are focused on improving our ability to diagnose, understand the mechanisms of and ultimately to treat rare genetic disorders. Current projects include the Undiagnosed Diseases Network site at Stanford, the Stanford site of the GREGoR consortium, the RDCRN Developmental Synaptopathies Consortium study of Phelan-McDermid syndrome. His research has spanned the areas of genetics, informatics, epidemiology and patient-centered outcomes.
