

Deena Chisolm, PhDProfessor of Pediatrics and Public Health The Ohio State University

Dr. Deena Chisolm is the Nationwide Foundation Endowed Chair in Health Equity Research and Professor of Pediatrics and Public Health at The Ohio State University. She is the Director of the Center for Child Health Equity and Outcomes Research and Vice-President for Health Services Research in the Abigail Wexner Research Institute at Nationwide Children's Hospital. Her research focuses on improving health and healthcare for children and families with over 100 peer-reviewed publications on pediatric health services, outcomes, and equity. Her current projects explore how healthcare delivery systems, health policy, and social factors influence the health. Beyond her work as an academic researcher, she is actively involved in promoting minority health and well-being in the community as a sought-after public speaker and member of policy setting and education bodies including the Columbus Board of Health and the Health Policy Institute of Ohio.
