Christoph Hornik, MD, MPH, PhD, is a tenured Professor in the Department of Pediatrics and the Duke Clinical Research Institute in the Duke University School of Medicine. He serves as vice chair for research in Pediatrics, director of the DCRI Pharmacometrics and Small Trials Program, and associate director of i-Cubed, DCRI's center for clinical research innovation. Dr. Hornik has dedicated his professional career to developing innovative approaches for the study of therapeutics and interventions in complex and vulnerable populations including children and minorities traditionally underrepresented in research. His work spans designing innovative approaches to clinical research, leading clinical trials including early-phase and decentralized trials, conducting pharmacometric analyses for submission to regulatory agencies, and applying novel approaches to real-world-evidence generation.
