Gary Kleiner is Associate Professor of Pediatrics and Surgery at University of Miami Miller School of Medicine and Chief of the Division of Pediatric Allergy and Clinical Immunology at University of Miami. After completing a MDPHD at SUNY Downstate, Dr Kleiner completed pediatric residency and allergy/immunology fellowship at Mt Sinai Medical Center, NY. He then pursued a pediatric hematopoietic stem cell transplant at Duke. Dr. Kleiner serves as the immunology expert for the FL department of health newborn screening advisory council. He serves on several A/I committees at AAAAI, CIS, ASBMT, CIBMTR and USIDnet. Dr Kleiner performs research in food allergy, and is Director of the University of Miami FARE Center of Excellence. He is the principal investigator for a trial investigating a drug to treat peanut allergy in children and adults. The center is collaborating with the School of Nursing and Mailman Center for Children to investigate interventions to alleviate food allergy anxiety in clinical settings.
