Su-Ting Li, MD, MPH, is Professor of Pediatrics in the Division of Pediatric Hospital Medicine at the University of California Davis, where she serves as Vice Chair of Education and Pediatric Residency Program Director. She received her B.A. from the University of California Davis, her MD from the University of California Los Angeles, and her MPH from the University of Washington. She completed her pediatric residency at Seattle Children's/University of Washington and her General Academic Pediatric Fellowship at the University of Washington.

Dr. Li's research focuses on improving competency-based medical education, self-regulated life-long learning, scholarly activity training, and faculty development. She has published over 90 peer-reviewed publications and presented over 100 national workshops / presentations. Nationally, Dr. Li serves on the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education Pediatric Review Committee, American Board of Pediatrics Education and Training Committee, American Academy of Pediatrics PediaLink Committee, and is Chair-Elect for the National Academy of Distinguished Educators in Pediatrics. She also serves as Associate Editor for Medical Education at *Academic Pediatrics*. Dr. Li was an inaugural Council Member, and then Chair, for the Association of Pediatric Program Directors Leadership in Educational Academic Development (APPD LEAD) faculty development program designed to train leaders and scholars in graduate medical education. Dr. Li was honored to receive the Robert S. Holm Leadership Award from the APPD for leadership and mentoring of pediatric program leaders.
