Dr. Fumihiko Namba is a neonatal intensive care physician-scientist working in one of the largest NICUs in Japan. Dr. Namba is a Professor of Pediatrics at Saitama Medical Center, Saitama Medical University. He is currently involved in research on prematurity-related diseases, such as bronchopulmonary dysplasia, patent ductus arteriosus, and retinopathy of prematurity using in vitro/in vivo models, cohort studies, clinical trials, national databases, and systematic review and meta-analysis. He is also a board member of the Japan Society for Neonatal Health and Development and chair of its International Liaison Committee.

Dr. Namba was born and grew up in the west of Japan. He received his medical degree from Okayama University and then pursued a residency in Pediatrics at Okayama University Hospital and its affiliated hospitals. He completed neonatal intensive care training at Okayama Medical Center and Osaka Medical Center and Research Institute for Maternal and Child Health. He also received a PhD degree in perinatology from Osaka University. Thereafter, he completed his postdoctoral fellowship in Neonatology at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia under the auspices of Dr. Phyllis Dennery.
