Kari A. Simonsen, MD, MBA, is the Chair of the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Nebraska Medical Center, Associate Dean for Pediatric Affairs (UNMC), and Pediatrician-in-Chief of Children's Nebraska. She is a tenured Professor of Pediatric Infectious Diseases at UNMC. She served previously as Hospital Epidemiologist of Children's Nebraska, and her research interests relate to infection prevention and control in pediatric settings, including high-consequence pathogens and biocontainment.

Dr. Simonsen received her undergraduate degree in Biological Sciences from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, her medical degree at the University of Nebraska Medical Center, and her MBA at the University of Nebraska-Omaha. She completed pediatric residency at Indiana University, and fellowship in Pediatric Infectious Diseases at Brown University.

She is a fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Pediatric Infectious Diseases Society and the Infectious Diseases Society of America, and a graduate of the Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine (ELAM) program. She serves PIDS as the Pediatric Academic Societies' meeting chair, program and meetings committee, and as a member of the finance committee. She is also an associate editor for the Society for Healthcare Epidemiology of America's journal *Antimicrobial Stewardship and Hospital Epidemiology*.
