Dr. Wyckoff is Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center and Director of Newborn Resuscitation Services at Parkland Memorial Hospital, a large, urban hospital with over 13,000 deliveries annually. She maintains and utilizes a comprehensive neonatal resuscitation database and runs a neonatal resuscitation simulation laboratory for research and training purposes. Dr. Wyckoff and her team have conducted multiple prospective resuscitation studies in the delivery room. She has served on the International Liaison Committee on Resuscitation, Neonatal Life Support Task Force since 2003 for which she just finished a 7-year term as Chair. She has served on the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Neonatal Resuscitation Program Steering Committee since 2006, recently served a 4-year term as co-chair and is currently ILCOR Liaison to the committee. She serves on the AAP American Heart Association Neonatal Life Support Guidelines Writing Group which creates the resuscitation guidelines for the United States. Dr. Wyckoff also serves as UTSW principle investigator for the NICHD Neonatal Research Network which conducts multi-center clinical trials and observational studies.
