Dr. Macy is a pediatric emergency medicine physician scientist who received her MD from the University of Michigan where she went on to complete a combined pediatric emergency medicine and pediatric health services research fellowship. She and her team in the Mary Ann & J. Milburn Smith Child Health Outcomes, Research, and Evaluation Center at Lurie Children's use innovative social, behavioral, and applied research approaches to improve the well-being, health, and healthcare of diverse populations of children. Her own academic interests are centered on eliminating inequities in two leading causes of childhood injury and death, motor vehicle collisions and drowning. Dr. Macy also works to identify and address disparities in access to high-value, high-quality pediatric care through work with Lurie Children's Pediatric Partners Clinically Integrated Network, the All Hands Health Network - funded through the CMMI Integrated Care for Kids program, and the Michigan Emergency Department Improvement Collaborative (MEDIC) - a Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan Value Partnerships Program.
