RECIPIENT



**Alan H. Jobe, MD, PhD**

After his BA at Stanford University, Dr Alan Jobe obtained his MD/PhD and his Neonatology Fellowship at the University of California, San Diego in 1977. He then joined the Department of Pediatrics, University of California, Los Angeles, where he became the first Joseph W. St. Geme, Jr., Professor of Pediatrics in 1995.

Jobe moved to the Department of Pediatrics and Neonatology, Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, in 1997, where he is currently Professor Emeritus. Jobe's research interests include surfactant homeostasis, lung injury and Bronchopulmonary Dysplasia, fetal lung development and fetal inflammation. Jobe

performed many metabolic and physiologic studies supporting FDA approval of surfactant treatment for the respiratory distress syndrome.

For 24 years he contributed collaborative research using sheep models, in Perth, Australia, studying fetal lung maturation, fetal inflammation and Bronchopulmonary Dysplasia. He served as Chair of the Steering Committee for the NICHD Neonatal Research Network and as an editor for Pediatric Research and for The Journal of Pediatrics. He has organized training seminars for young pediatric faculty in Estonia, Poland, and Hungary for the Society for Pediatric Research.

A member of the National Academy of Medicine, Dr. Jobe has received, among others, the Johnson Award for Pediatric Research, the Finnish Pediatric Society Arvo Ylppö Medal, the George Simbrunerr, New Frontiers in Neonatology, Lecturing Award, the Society for Pediatric Research Thomas Hazinski Distinguished Service Award, the American Thoracic Society Pediatric Assembly Founders Award and the American Pediatric Society John Howland Award. Jobe lists 437 peer-reviewed publications and over 260 other publications.

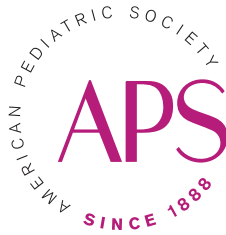
