Maya Bunik, MD, MPH, is a Professor of Pediatrics at University of Colorado School of Medicine and Bonnie W. Camp Distinguished Professor in Pediatrics and Pediatrics and Associate Chief Medical Officer, Ambulatory at Children's Hospital Colorado. She is the current Chair of the Section on Breastfeeding for the American Academy of Pediatrics. She is also the lead editor of Current Diagnosis and Treatment, a large general pediatric textbook in its 27th edition.

Clinically, she leads the BF Management Clinic 'Trifecta Team' (pediatrician, lactation specialist and psychologist) at Children's Hospital Colorado and has been helping mother-baby pairs for over 25 years. Prior to her ACMO promotion, she served as medical director of the large primary care teaching clinic for 15 years

Dr. Bunik's health services research interest lies in improving healthy early infant feeding practices and development. She has over 40 publications on topics of breastfeeding support for Latinx mothers, quality improvement research with screening for pregnancy-related depression, developmental delay, integrated behavioral health, secondhand smoke (SHS), asthma as well as well child care continuity and adherence. Her book, <u>Breastfeeding Telephone Triage and Advice</u> published by the American Academy of Pediatrics (soon in its 5th edition) as a helpful resource for physician practices and anyone providing advice for breastfeeding.
