An international authority in cardiovascular abnormalities of Williams syndrome, as well as an expert in cardiovascular genetics and adult congenital heart disease, his research spans basic to clinical studies. In addition to his medical research, Dr. Collins studies leadership, including interviews with 51 Four-Star Generals and Admirals, which inspired his forthcoming book *The Four Stars of Leadership*. He also hosts *The Science of Leadership* podcast, discussing vital leadership lessons and their scientific foundations.
