Dr. Suni Kaiser is a Professor of Pediatrics and Epidemiology & Biostatistics at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). She also serves as head of the Pediatric Hospital Medicine Division at UCSF, Chair of the Pediatric Research in Inpatient Settings (PRIS) Network, and National Steering Committee member for the American Academy of Pediatrics' Pediatric Acute and Critical Care (APP-PACC) Quality Network. She is an NIH-funded health services researcher. The goals of her research program include: 1) accelerating the pace at which evidence is broadly implemented into care to improve hospital care quality, 2) leveraging quality improvement efforts to advance health equity, and 3) growing and synthesizing the evidence base around care of common diagnoses among hospitalized children.
