Brian Lurie, MD, MPH, is the Pediatric Residency Program Director at Brown University Health -Hasbro Children's in Providence, Rhode Island and an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at The Warren Alpert School of Medicine of Brown University. Prior to taking on his current position, Brian has served in multiple academic roles including Associate Pediatric Residency Program Director, the Division Director of General Academic Pediatrics, Continuity Clinic Site Director, and Director of the Medical Student Clerkship. Brian graduated from Tufts University with a degree in Clinical Psychology before attending medical school at the Sackler School of Medicine NY state/American Program. He also obtained his Master of Public Health at Columbia University Mailman School of Public Health. Clinically he is an Academic General Pediatrician with specific interest in working with LGBTQA+ youth and other underserved and marginalized populations. He has served as the Association of Pediatric Program Director's Cochair of the LGBTQA+ Learning Community, and Co-chair and founding member of the Academic Pediatric Association's LGBTQ Health and Well Being SIG. Brian has experience developing and implementing a curriculum for Pediatric Residents on caring for patients who are LGBTQA+. He has published on this topic and has given multiple talks and led multiple workshops nationally focusing on LGBTQA+ care, diversity and inclusion, and social justice in medicine. Currently, Brian is the Chair of the Association of Pediatric Program Director's Brave Action Team, a committee dedicated to advocating for and ensuring the education for all residents to take care of all patients.
