Marissa Raymond-Flesch is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics in UCSF's Division of Adolescent and Young Adult Medicine and the Philip R. Lee Institute for Health Policy Studies. Her research focuses on the health and health care access of California's Latinx and immigrant populations, with a particular focus on mental and reproductive health. Her current projects span three areas of research: (1) the mental and reproductive health outcomes of adolescent and young adult immigrants; (2) strategies for expanding adolescent and young adult access to abortion services and (3) investigating the use of psychedelic-assisted therapy for the treatment of anorexia nervosa. Clinically she practices Adolescent and Young Adult Medicine with patients 12 to 26 years old, including treatment of depression, anxiety and eating disorders; providing all types of contraception; and providing primary care for patients with complex medical and mental health conditions.
