

Jennifer Takagishi, MD Professor of Pediatrics University of South Florida

Dr. Jennifer Takagishi is Professor of Pediatrics and Division Chief of General Academic Pediatrics at the University of South Florida, holding the John and Aliese Price Endowed Chair in Pediatrics and Adolescent Medicine. She serves as the Statewide and Regional Medical Director for Medical Foster Care and the Children's Multidisciplinary Assessment Teams, two Department of Health programs providing oversight for children with medical complexity in the foster care system. Dr. Takagishi received her B.A. from Wellesley, M.D. from Tufts and completed her residency at Duke. She received a certificate from the Academic Pediatric Association Educational Scholars Program and graduated from Drexel University's Executive Leadership in Health Care program. She has served on the Executive Committee of the American Academy of Pediatrics Council on Early Childhood and currently serves on the Florida Chapter of the AAP's Executive Committee. Her publications and presentations center around resident education and early childhood.
