

Julie Lounds Taylor, PhD Professor of Pediatrics Vanderbilt University Medical Center

Julie Lounds Taylor, PhD, is Professor of Pediatrics at Vanderbilt University Medical Center and the Co-Director of the Vanderbilt Center for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities. She also holds an Endowed Directorship in Autism Research at Vanderbilt. She received her PhD in Developmental Psychology from the University of Notre Dame and completed a post-doctoral fellowship in lifespan family research at the Waisman Center, University of Wisconsin-Madison. Her research focuses on understanding the factors that promote positive outcomes for adults on the autism spectrum and their families, particularly during the transition to adulthood. Dr. Taylor's research has been funded by National Institute of Mental Health, the U.S Department of Education's Institute for Educational Sciences, the US Department of Defense's Autism Research Program, and the FAR fund.
