Dr. Michelle Terry is the Assistant Dean in the Office of Faculty Affairs and Clinical Professor in Pediatrics at the University of Washington School of Medicine and has served in several leadership roles in clinical care, medical education, career coaching, medical regulation, and advocacy. Michelle has been a PCP in a physician-owned private practice; a PCP in a multispecialty clinic; and currently works in the Division of Hospital Medicine at Seattle Children's, where she provides inpatient medical care.

In service to the medical profession, she is the former member and chair of the Washington Medical Commission, which oversees physician licensing, policy, education, and discipline; is the immediate past president of the King County Medical Society, whose mission is to advocate for physicians and patients concerning local, state, and federal matters; is a delegate to the Washington State Medical Association; and serves on the American Academy of Pediatrics Committee on Medical Liability and Risk Management.

Dr. Terry received her BA in Human Biology from Stanford University, MD from Baylor College of Medicine, completed residency in Pediatrics at the University of Washington, and is a past recipient of an Open Society Foundation's Physician Advocacy Fellowship.
