Rooted in her clinical experience as a pediatric nurse practitioner specializing in pulmonary and sleep disorders, Teresa collaborates with interdisciplinary teams and families to design interventions using a socio-ecological approach, addressing sociocultural and neighborhood factors that influence sleep.
